

## Mallinckrodt Uveitis Research Fellowship

The Mallinckrodt Uveitis Research Fellowship provides a one-year research grant in the amount of \$45,000 to an early career investigator to support a well-conceived research project focused on an aspect of uveitis or other inflammatory condition of the eye, including the understanding of the role and interplay of infections and intraocular inflammation.

The intent of the award is to provide investigators who are early in their careers with an opportunity to explore novel and innovative ideas and to promote the generation of promising preliminary results that may be leveraged to catalyze success in both in earning additional, longer-term funding support as well as the authorship of impactful publications and the stimulation of further insights and advances in the ocular inflammation space.
